

BOARD POLICY

ADMINISTRATION IN THE ABSENCE OF POLICY OR PROCEDURE

The superintendent/designee shall be authorized to use his/her best judgment in the absence of a specific policy or procedure, provided that such action shall not be in conflict with the general aims and objectives of the district or with any local, state or national ordinances, statutes, regulations or directives.

Whenever action in the absence of specific policy has been taken by the superintendent/ designee which creates a potential for controversy, a potential for the incurring of district financial obligation and/or where the situation is likely to recur frequently, then such action shall be brought to the attention of the board at its next regular meeting. In situations where a reasonable person could determine that the above actions taken by the superintendent/designee/staff member should be brought to the immediate attention of the board, the superintendent shall immediately consult with the board president as to the advisability of calling a special board meeting to review the action.
